## DLA Aquatic Invasives (AIS) Initiative

Please participate in DLA's AIS Initiative:

- Know which waters are infested <http://www.eddmaps.org/midwest/tools/infestedwaters/map.cfm?showheader=1>
- Know whether your or your guests' owned or rented boats and gear have been in infested waters.
- Practice Clean, Drain, Dispose and Dry
- If waters are infested, drain and dry boats and trailers in the sun for at least 5 days, remove AIS manually, or decontaminate with very hot water - 140° for 10 seconds or 120° for two minutes. <https://www.itascawcd.org/ais-decon-station-locations>
- Dry lifts/docks at least 21 days before moving
- Don't let others use your private launch unless you know where their boats have been
- Pls patronize **DLA FiveStar** service providers when you:
  - Install/remove dock/lift
  - Service boat and engine
  - Rent trailers, boats and gear
  - Purchase used gear /equipment<http://deerlakeassociation.org/index.cfm?pageid=262011>
