President's Message

Deer Lake water quality serves as a foundation for family life and lakeshore property values. All property owners can unite around the goal of improving water quality. Phosphorus is a nutrient that causes algae and weed growth. Deer Lake is sensitive to phosphorus loading, meaning that additional phosphorus causes a disproportionate decrease in water quality. The good news is that this sensitivity also means that *if we reduce the amount of phosphorus running into the lake, water quality will increase disproportionately*.

DLA's **Beautiful Deer Lake** Water Quality Initiative has two goals: reduce phosphorus loading from streams, septics, storm-water run-off, and shoreline erosion; and to prevent aquatic invasives (AIS) from infesting Deer Lake. We need your help. *Your individual action could make the difference*. Later this spring, you will receive information describing our Initiative and asking for your participation. **Please join our effort to prevent AIS infestation and improve Deer Lake water quality**. Not transferable. \$12.50 Associate Annual Membership: Any person, family, firm, association, corporation or other legal entity which does not qualify for Annual Membership.
